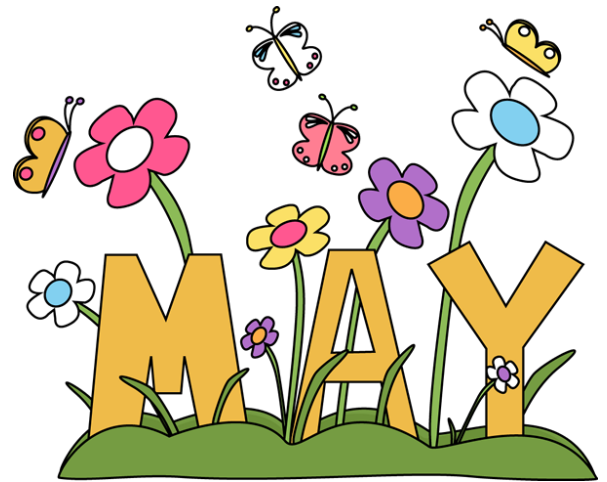

Before- and After-School Childcare for 2017-18
